## RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ADMISSION

Admission shall open to the intermediate studants after the declaration of matriculation results and for Ba./B.Sc after announcement of intermediate results. Copies of the prospectus can be obtained from the office during office hours on payment of Rs.350/- The admission from must be supported by the attested copies of the following documuents.

- Detailed marks certificate of the last examination passed 03 copy..
- Provisional certificate if the last examination passed.
- Character certificate 01.
- Migration certificate should be provided if candidate has passed the last examination form other board than BISE Peshawar and incase of ADP(ADA+ADS) must be submitted at the time of Admission.
- Domicile 03.
- National Identity Card of the Father / Guardian 03.
- Four Pictures (Passport size with blue background for F.A / Fsc \& with background for ADP(ADA+ADS)


## WARNING

1. Admission shall be made on open merit basis due to the limited number of seats.
2. The institute shall University application for concession from regular students, subject to the results and regulations of the B.I.S.E and the University of Peshawar.
3. Foreign students with the requisite educational qualifications, in the relevant subject shall be given admission following the official procedure of the B.I.S.E and ane the University of Peshawar
4. Those Passing there matriculation, F.A or F.Sc in the supplementary examination shall not be admitted as regular candidates.
5. Each student will be given one week to change their subjects after commencement of classes.
6. Candidates who do not apply for admission in time or fail to appear for the interview shall not claim the right for admission. Late admission shall be discouraged due to prerequisite of $75 \%$ attendance in all categories as per rules and regulation. of B.I.S.E and University of Peshawar.
7. In hardareas or special areas subject to Payment of late fee as per regulation of the B.I.S.E and University of Peshawar.

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## ACADEMICS

1. All students are required to attain $75 \%$ attendance in each subject, failing which they will be issued a warning letter and in extreme shortage at attendance they will disqualified from appearing as regular students.
2. The detention examination is compulsory for all students: those failing to appear for the detention examination without valid reason will not be permitted to appear as regular students.
3. Distinction badges / Certificates will be awarded to the students who obtain positions in tests / Examination.

## TESTS \& EVALUATION SYSTEM

At the college we have two types of testing and evaluations system.

## MONTHLY TESTS



Monthly tests are held regularly throughout the academic year, at the end of each month.

## DETENTION AND PRE-BOARD EXAMINATION

The college conducts a detention and a pre- Board examination during the academic year. The result is also conveyed to the parents of students as well. Participation of students in the monthly tests / Detention \& pre-Board examination is compulsory. In case of absence from the monthly tests a fine of Rs. 200 per paper is imposed, while in case of absence from the Detention pre-Board examination, a fine Rs. 500 per paper is imposed on a students. Through home examination the college tries its best to train the students and prepare them not only for the final board examination, but also train them for the entry test conducted in the professional college.

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## DISCIPLINE

1. All the students will come to the institute in proper uniform.
2. No students will leave the institute without permission.
3. Half day leave shall not be allowed, unless the parents contact the principal in person.
4. Punctuality shall be strictly maintained: late comers in the morning will not be allowed to enter class without permission from the principal and shall be fined Rs. 100/- per days.
5. Students shall not be allowed to see visitors during study hours unless valid reasons is intimated to the office by the parents
6. students having appointment with Doctor. Dentists should arrange for visits from their homes .
7. Ornaments and makeup shall no be allowed at the institute.
8. Musical instruments, transistors, tape recorders and mobile phones laptops etc should not be brought to the institute.
9. Fine will be imposed on students, responsible for damage or the college property
10. Valuable objects should not be brought to the institute.
11. A proctorial board comprising of staff members as its head, and students proctors from all classes, will be formed to maintain cleanliness, discipline and coordination between the students and staff.
12. Students must report problems pertaining to academics/discipline and transport to the inchange staff members whose names will be put on the student's notice board.
13. As laid down in the prospectus, each students will have to clear the entire dues owing to the college before she takes the annual examination
14. Any students with a health problems must inform the institute at time of admission, failing the institute will not be responsible for causalities. If the problem is of severe nature she may be asked to leave.
15. The students will regularly attend all institute functions, they will be penalized and heavily fined for failing to do so.

NOTE: students are advisid to follow the regulations of the institute. Fine will be imposed for breaking rules and disruption the discipline fo the institute. Parents are requested to follow the progress of their child, and to see that they do not continuously break rules, for which they may be asked to leave or be expelled in extreme cases.

## COLLEGE SELECTION OF HEAD GIRLS

As discipline is the bridge between goals and accomplishment, and it always need commitment and dedication. For this purpose, we hold a proper election for the selection of head girl, through which we also polish the activities and interests of students by respecting their opinions and votes.

## OATH CEREMONY

The arrangement of proper ceremony for oath taking is carried out for the purpose of setting their goals and vision and reminding them their duties as responsible and active members.

## SESSION ASSEMBLY

To come together for a new beginning to encourage \& promotes the excellence of our generation. To keep them stand with encouragement. The deserving students achieve the prizes and rewards for their hard work and success.

## MORNING ASSEMBLY

Morning Assembly is held on regular basis to start the day with the holy name of Allah and a three minutes talk to the students to make them bold and courageous.

## PARENTS TEACHERS MEETING

A parent-teacher conference is a short meeting and conference between teachers and parents of students to discuss children's progress at college and find solutions to academic or behavioral problems.


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## PROCTORIAL BOARD

Peaceful and congenial environment is very important for an educational institute
Good discipline brings congenial environment and peace in an institute.
3. To maintains strict disciplinary standards in the institute, the proctorial board has to play a major role. The board is headed by a disciplinarian lecturer from amongst the teaching staff and a senior student acts as the head girl of the institute with a team of proctors. Their duties are as under:

- To insure that proper discipline is maintained during the study hours.
- To keep the chief proctor / head girls informed about irregularities, indiscipline. Disturbance and indecent behavior of the students.
- To ensure that students are in proper uniform and representing the institute in an upright manner are all occasions / functions.
- Last, but not the least, their self discipline should be exemplary.



## LIBRARY

The college library basically lends books to staff and students having their membership. Membership is the Pre-requirement for availing the lending facilities.

## MEMBERSHIP

Regular staff and students of the college are eligible for membership.
At a time degree student of the college can barrow 3 books at the most.
An intermediate student can borrow 2 books at the most.
The student can retain the book for 2 weeks, which can be renewed for a further period of 2 weeks, if so presented on the due date.
Rs. 50 per book is charged as fine in case of late return of books from the students.
In case fo loss or damage to a book, market rates charged from borrowers.
General and text books are issued on first come first serve basis.

## TRANSPORT FACILITY

If any students forgo the use of college transport, she must serve one month written notice before leaving the college transport. The college transport is not compelled to drop students at any other place, than their own residence, without prior permission.

## COLLEGE UNIFORM

UNIFORM WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE COLLEGE
Students are expected to wear full uniform.
The uniform should be clean, properly ironed and shoes well polished.
All kind of jewelery is prohibited.
Violation of uniform is punishable by a fine of Rs. 50 per day.

## CANTEEN

The college has a canteen for snacks, soft drinks, and simple lunch. It also has no stock, stationery, educational materials and some items of daily need. Rates are controlled by an incharge of canteen.


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## LEAVE POLICY

Only one day leave in a month will be granted to a student. More than one day, parents have to see the principal in person.
No half-day leave is allowed unless the parents of the students request in person.
No medical leave will be granted on the basis of medical certificate, unless the parents of the student request in person.
No leave will granted during examination and practical.
Any students found leaving the college premises without permission, would be dealt with severally. Her parents will be informed.
During the college hours, no student can leave the college premises except by written permission of the principal.
No student is allowed to proceed on leave during the academic session except under every exceptional circumstances of genuine emergency. Medical leave will be given only, on the production of medical certificate and request by the parents in person to the principal.
In all cases. Leave availed will be on students own risk, so far, as the required percentage of attendance is concerned and even a medical certificate will not condone a deficiency in attendance and request by the parents in person to principal.

## IDENTITY CARD

It is binding upon every student to obtain the institute identity card within twenty days of her admission and keep it with her during the study hours. The institute identity card will be issued to all the students within fifteen days from the date of their admission. In case of loss or damage, a duplicate identity card will be issued on payment of Rs. 100

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## CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

An important feature of our education system is the stress laid on extra curricular activities. These activities are an important part of the social and intellectual environment of the college: various activities related to the subjects of institute are planned and carried out throughout the year. English, Urdu, declamations and debates, Qirat and Naat Khuwani competitions are held every year. Talented girls gatherings are arranged on national level.


The students work in various committees to help, plan and conduct these functions. Student's educational trips are compulsory for all students. The purpose of these trips is to encourage the students to have interest in the practical aspects of life. The athletics club will cater for a vast variety of conventional sports, like football, basketball, badminton, baseball and also indoor games.
